## 5. Important points

- 1. Program starts at 9 a.m. Be on campus on time.
- 2. You must call Center for Student Affairs if you cannot make it on time.
- 3. Leave contact information, accommodation address, name, telephone number, with your family or dormitory.
- 4. All meals are served at the accommodation. Alcohol is strictly forbidden.
- 5. Keep your room clean and organized.
- 6. Keep noise level to a minimum after 10p.m.
- 7. Smoking is allowed only in designated area. And be careful with fire. Underage (under 20) smoking is illegal.
- 8. Check emergency exits and routes at the accommodation.
- 9. Bring your own medicine (pain, cold, digestive medicine etc.). Medicine will not be provided to student from the university to prevent allergy or side-effects from medicine.
- 10. Students with food allergy that may cause serious symptoms, or students who have food restrictions for religious reasons, may have their menu items changed at the accommodation. Please inform the FLA office staff at the departmental assembly on April 1.

#### 7. Prevention of COVID-19

- When participating in the program, pay attention to thorough measures to prevent Covid-19 infection. For the latest Covid-19 information, regularly check "Information on COVID-19" on the official Sophia University website (URL: <a href="https://piloti.sophia.ac.jp/eng/article/news/general/covid19/">https://piloti.sophia.ac.jp/eng/article/news/general/covid19/</a>), the official Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare website, and other official information sources.
- Maintain ventilation in departmental assembly venues and accommodation rooms during the program implementation period.
- At the facility, in places where only Sophia University related persons are present, whether or not to wear a mask is left to your own judgment. But please do not forget to be considerate of members who may be anxious due to underlying illnesses, etc., and act in a way that respects each other. In addition, in places with a group or other people who are not related to Sophia University, please bring, and wear your own

mask.

- Practice frequent hand washing and disinfection around campus, on buses, and in the accommodation facilities. Alcohol sanitizer is provided at the entrances to campus buildings and accommodation facilities, and in cafeterias, so please cooperate in disinfection.
- Bedding should always be covered with sheets and covers before use.
- Avoid using baths when they are crowded.
- The cafeteria of the accommodation facility is self-service. When taking food, wear a mask and the vinyl gloves provided. Use alcohol wet napkins provided by the cafeteria before eating. Acrylic panels have been placed on each table to prevent infection via droplets. During mealtime, keep conversation low while unmasked.
- Those who are unwell are not allowed to enter campus or participate in this program. In particular, those with fever, respiratory symptoms, fatigue, other cold-like symptoms, or abnormal senses of smell or taste should remain at home. Everyone should check their temperature before leaving home on the day of departure, and stay at home if their temperature exceeds 37.5°C.
