

Part-time Teaching Position in Art History and Visual Culture

Description

The Faculty of Liberal Arts at Sophia University, in Tokyo, Japan, seeks qualified part-time instructors to teach two upper-level undergraduate courses in Art History and Visual Culture (ART411 “Seminar in Visual Culture” and ART461 “Seminar in Art History”) for the fall semester, 2023 academic year. These courses, to be taught in English, will focus on themes or topics proposed by the instructor at the time of application. Classes meet twice a week during a 14-week semester. Each class period is 100 minutes.

Contract

Yearly and renewable, in principle, up to five years. (*Maximum years of employment may vary according to personnel and curriculum needs of the FLA and Sophia School Corporation).

Salary and benefits are based on Sophia School Corporation’s rules and regulations.

If the applicant is not a citizen of Japan, it will be necessary to hold valid residential status that allows one to work in Japan legally.

Qualifications

We welcome applications from ABDs, recently graduated PhDs and established scholars.

Applicants with PhDs and with teaching experience are preferred.
