<u>IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS:</u> (Diseases to be checked: measles, rubella, mumps, chicken pox)

For prevention of infectious diseases after enrolling in the University, all incoming students are required to have received 2 doses of the vaccination for the diseases indicated above. If you have not received 2 doses of the vaccine, please consult a family doctor about getting the vaccine before enrollment. Please confirm a record of the vaccination and if necessary, you should be vaccinated before enrollment.

XII is not necessary to submit the result of the test and the certificate of vaccination to the Health and Wellbeing Center. We recommend keeping the certificate yourself in case of need it.

**There are various types of vaccination depends on the country. Please consult a family doctor about an unclear point.
