Sophia University's Faculty of Science and Technology is recruiting one full-time faculty member for the Department of Information and Communication Sciences, as follows.

1. Name of faculty position and number of persons to be employed:
One (1) Associate Professor or Assistant Professor
*For Assistant Professor: The term of appointment is five years, with possible promotion to Associate Professor. The position is based on an annual salary system.
2. Field of expertise:
Information Security, Cyber Security, Network Security, and related fields
3. Assigned duties
 - 1) The courses to be assigned will be determined from the following categories, taking into consideration the applicant's field of expertise.
 - (1) Faculty core courses (Digital Circuit, Fundamentals of Information and Communication Engineering, etc.)
 - (2) Department core courses (Information and Communication Sciences Lab. I/II, Information and Communication Sciences, etc.)
 - (3) Department specialized courses (Information Security, etc.)
 - (4) Graduate school courses (Advanced Information Security, etc.)
 - (5) General studies (Information Fluency, etc.)
 - (6) Others (seminars, supervision for graduation research, etc.)
 - 2) Faculty and departmental administration

5. Eligibility requirements

It is seeking individuals who understand the university's founding philosophy and educational spirit and are enthusiastic about engaging in education, research, university administration, admissions-related work, and other duties required by the university.
 - The applicant must have obtained or be on track to obtain a doctoral degree by the time they assume the position.
 - The applicant must have the ability to supervise undergraduate students' graduation research and graduate students' research.
 - For associate professors, the ability to teach in English is a requirement. For assistant professors, the ability to teach in English is desirable.

- (8) Information of two reference persons (names and contact information) who can be contacted about the applicant

10. Screening method

First screening: Screening of documents

Second screening (for those who pass the document screening): You will be asked to conduct a public seminar outlining your aspirations for education and research after assuming the position, as well as introducing your own research. This will be followed by an interview. The date and time will be communicated directly to the applicant.

- You are expected to operate your own independent laboratory from your first year of appointment and to actively pursue your own research and students' graduation research in addition to teaching.
