He also taught globalization at the Institut d'Etudes Politiques (Institute of Political Studies, "Sciences Po") in Paris. The Asian Century Institute, of which John is Executive Director, conducts research and analysis, and participates in policy dialogues to foster a better understanding of the opportunities and challenges of the Asian Century.

In these various positions, John has conducted research and analysis of diverse aspects of Asia's economic, social and political development, and authored and edited many major international studies.
