■Japanese Placement Test

Students who wish to take Japanese language courses have to take the Japanese Placement Test (JPT) and will be placed in classes at the right level based on the results. The Japanese Placement Test is **from March 7 to 21**. Please read the guidelines on pages 3 & 4 of "**Japanese Language Program Spring semester 2022**" brochure. Students are required to submit 1) the score of designated online examinations, 2) the questionnaire of their Japanese learning background and 3) an essay on designated subject in Japanese by March 21.

Students without any knowledge of Japanese DO NOT need to submit the test score, instead, they need to send their Japanese learning background info via a "Submission Form for Japanese Placement Test" by March 21.
